## The Bedrock of Israelite Society: A Proclamation to the World

I, a Follower of the Way, solemnly proclaim that a lawful marriage is only between an unadulterated (pure) man of one race with an unadulterated (pure) woman of that same race, that the family is the basic bedrock of Israelite society, and is central to the Father's plan for His people Israel. Marriage is ordained of Yahuah, and the State has absolutely no authority in the realm of marriage.

One of our earliest commandments was to be fruitful and multiply (Genesis 1:28). This command remains. I urge you to keep this command, in faith, that the Father bless you in all your works. As a command, it is absolutely implied that He Who gives you the children will surely provide for them. It is only through faithlessness and laziness that Adamic children go hungry. He who rejects the divine command to multiply children is a lawbreaker and is thus guilty of violating the whole of the Law (James 2:10). [There are some exceptions to this, i.e. someone who has made themselves a eunuch for the sake of the Kingdom of Yah (Matthew 19:12).]

Husbands, you have a solemn responsibility to provide for, care for, and love your wife, as Yahushua loves us (Colossians 3:19).

Wives, you have a solemn responsibility to care for, submit to, and cherish your husband, as to Yahushua (Colossians 3:18; 1 Peter. 3:1-6).

Parents, you have a solemn responsibility, a sacred duty, to rear your children in love and righteousness, to provide for their physical, mental, and spiritual needs, to teach them to love and serve one another (Luke 22:39; Leviticus 19:18), and to observe the commandments of Yahuah the Mighty One of Israel (Deuteronomy 6:6-9) in love for Him (Deuteronomy 6:15; Luke 10:27). Happiness and fulfillment in life are built upon these commandments and the teachings of Yahushua, the Anointed One. Both successful marriages and families, are established, and maintained, on the principles of faith, prayer, repentance, forgiveness, respect, love, compassion, fulfillment of duty, fellowship, and Law.

By divine design fathers are to preside over their families in love, not ruling with an iron rod, except when necessary (Pro. 13:24. 29:15; Hebrews 12:6); in honour, giving preference to his wife as the weaker vessel (1 Peter 3:7), and the children as a heritage from Yahuah (Psalm 127:3); in righteousness, fulfilling the Law as their example (1 Corinthians 11:1); providing the necessities of life and protection for them as their covering.

Mothers are responsible for the nurture of the children, aiding the provision of the family and keeping the home (Proverbs 31:13-19, 21-22, 24, 24), as well as being the help-meet of the husband (Genesis 2:18).

I call upon all Followers of the Way to fulfill their Yah-given duty to populate the earth with Yah-fearing sons and daughters, and to live a set-apart life in Yahushua. May Yah give you life, strength, and happiness.
